## **Divisions and Principles**

## The Studies of the Book of Daniel and the Gospel of Mark "Daniel's Seventy Weeks" Daniel 9:1-27



<b>Division 2:</b> God is faithful to answer prayers of a diligent seeker.  Daniel 9:20-23
(Additional passages: Isaiah 65:24; Leviticus 26:34-35)

**Principle #1**: Diligent, sincere prayer repairs, restores, and returns sinful hearts back to God.

**Principle #2**: Since we know God hears and answers our prayers, we should avail ourselves to this privilege every day in every aspect of our lives

**Division 3:** Prophecy authenticates the Bible and its Author when viewed through the lens of history. Daniel 9:24-27 (Additional passages: Isaiah 46:10) **Principle #4**: God inhabits eternity, which is outside of time. Therefore, from God's perspective, prophecy is simply history written in advance.

**Principle #3**: Prophecy is often written in symbolic and poetic language, but it reports real things, places, and events.

**Principle #5**: Unravelling prophecies require understanding them from the perspective of a Jewish audience, and we should be careful not to casually apply modern American perceptions into their interpretation.
