## The Studies of the Book of Daniel and the Gospel of Mark Lesson 9: "Jesus Helps Many People" (or The Blindness of Religion)



Mark 7:1 - 8:26

<b>Division 1:</b> All religion at its core assumes a works-based solution or salvation. But Christ alone gives the righteousness of salvation.  Mark 7:1-23  (Additional passages: Matthew 15:1-20, Genesis 12:2-3, Romans 12:2-3, Ephesians 4:18)	<b>Division 2:</b> Christ does not send away the faithful empty handed.  Mark 7:24-37  (Additional Passage: Matthew 15:21-31; I Peter 1:3-7; Ephesians 1:1-3; Ephesians 1:11-14; Romans 6:2-11; Philippians 1:1; Genesis 12:3; Revelation 21:6-7)

**Principle #1**: Ceremonial cleanliness or conformance to man-made traditions can never purify the sinful heart or open the darkened mind of an unbeliever.

**Principle #2**: We should not fear wanting or lack in this life if we have Christ, because in Him we will inherit all things.

<b>Division 3:</b> When blindness is a sin.  Mark 8:1-26	(for additional notes)
(Additional Passage: Matthew 15:39-16:12; Ephesians 4:17-18)	

**Principle #3**: It is a sin to demand more of God than He has already. Demanding a "sign" from God to convince you to submit to Him is not faith, it is willful spiritual blindness.
