	Principle #2: God the Father has purpose in the struggles we face. Through Christ He redeems us from our sin, and through the Holy Spirit

**Principle #1**: Whatever we suffer here on earth, is of no value when compared with being returned to the purpose that God intended for his children in His perfect creation.

Through Christ He redeems us from our sin, and through the Holy Spirit He knows us and prays for our Christ-like transformation as well as strengthening us to live as a new creation that testifies to the power of Jesus Christ's redemption.

<b>Principle #3</b> : All humans are called by God to repent and believe in Jesus Christ. God knew who would answer the call, so He predestined that they would be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ. God	
promises that He is working for our good through the discipline of the Holy Spirit in our lives, and God who justifies us promises to glorify us	
when we die.
