Principle #1: God elected to save only those people who obtain righteousness by faith; those people will never be rejected by the Father because they are His inheritance from the Son.

Principle #2: God partially hardened ethnic Israel in judgment by withholding Truth from Israel, because Israel refused to believe the Truth it had.
